Lisbon Experience by Tram, including Castle S. Jorge and Historical Alfama District

- 09.00 Departure from the Hotel Miragem Cascais by buss with guide.
- Upon arrival in Lisbon guests embarque the iconic yellow Lisbon Tram to get to know the most important sights of Lisbon.
- The yellow tram we will pass some of Lisbon's most typical sights, such as São Bento Palace, Downtown, Lisbon Cathedral etc. The tram ride will last about 40 minutes and finishes at the medieval Alfama quarter, the oldest of Lisbon.
- The **Alfama District** is an appealing warren of narrow streets and blind alleys, stooping archways and twisting staircases. Some of the buildings around here stand on foundations dating back to the Visigoths, but the street pattern is Moorish.
- We will then stop at **Alfama** for a small walking tour up to the **Castle of St George** for a visit where magnificent views can be admired of the city of Lisbon.
- Lunch at Restaurant **Museu da cerveja**, a space of culture, cuisine and beer, which celebrates the beer heritage of the Countries of Portuguese language and Expression.
- 16:00 Arrival at Hotel Miragem Cascais.
